Get Ready for the 1st Central Avenue Auto and Music Show

This event is organized by the CASID in partnership with Mayor Steven M. Fulop, The City of Jersey City Municipal Council, and the Office of Cultural Affairs. The new Auto and Music Show is a sign of the times demonstrating the resilience of our neighborhood and business community."
