

PEDDLERS

IN THE CENTRAL AVENUE SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

Per Jersey City Municipal Code § 245-6

"PEDDLER - Any person, traveling by foot, wagon, automotive vehicle or any other type of conveyance from place to place, from house to house or from street to street, carrying, conveying or transporting goods, wares or merchandise, offering and exposing the same for sale, or making sales and delivering articles to purchasers, or who, without traveling from place to place, shall sell or offer the same for sale from a wagon, automotive vehicle, railroad car or other vehicle or conveyance" (Jersey City Municipal Code § 245-1).

"No peddler may sell or offer to sell any goods, wares or merchandise within the area...designated as...The Central Avenue Special Improvement District...which area...[is] more particularly described by block and lot numbers and street addresses as set forth in Schedule A to Chapter 69 of this Code on file in the Office of the Jersey City Clerk" (Jersey City Municipal Code, § 245-6).
